

2010-2011 Thurmont Lions Club Photo Contest

Here's a chance to have some fun with your new digital camera! The Thurmont Lions Club is having a photo contest. We're looking for a great picture to feature on our 2011 Birthday Calendar. If it's yours, your entry will be featured on the calendar along with your name in the photo credits! Here are the rules (what's a contest without rules?) and guidelines:

- Contest starts September 15, 2010 and ends March 15, 2011. This allows you time to take advantage of all four seasons and several holiday events.
- Entries will be accepted from residents living in the towns served by Catoclin High School (for example, Sabillasville, Lewistown, Emmitsburg, Thurmont).
- There is a limit of ONE photograph per person. Sorry, entries with more than one photo will be ineligible.
- Only submit a photograph that you took and own. By submitting a photo, you are stating that the photo is your property and that you have not sold or donated the rights to another party.
- By entering this contest, you are giving permission to the Thurmont Lions Club to use your photograph in Thurmont Lions Club activities without further request for permission to do so. For example, in addition to the Lions Club Birthday Calendar, your photograph may be shown (with credit to you as the photographer) on the Thurmont Lions Club website, the Thurmont Lions Club Newsletter and other Lions publications. If your entry does not win, we may still feature it on our website as one of the entries we liked!
- The photograph should be taken in the Thurmont area, as this will be of the most interest to those who subscribe to our birthday calendar.
- No photos of people, please. To respect the rights and privacy of others, no photos of people will be considered in the contest.
- To submit your entry, attach your photograph to an e-mail note that contains your **name, address, phone number and e-mail** address. In the 'subject' line, type "Photo Contest Entry from (your name)". Send your entry to Lionsphotos@hotmail.com. All entries must be received by midnight on March, 15, 2011.

About Your Digital Photograph Entry

- Photo must be in the JPEG (JPG) format. (Note: if your camera does not produce JPEG photos, tools are available on the internet that will convert them for you).
- Take your photo using the camera setting on your camera that yields the best quality.
- You may use common photo tools to frame your picture; however, using photo editors like 'Photo Shop' is not allowed.
